Panel Upgrade	Up to \$5,000	NA
Prewiring	\$1,500 per port, up to 10 per property	NA

All incentives must be reserved before purchase or installation.

***Incentive Cap:** For new construction affordable housing, up to 100% of total costs. For existing buildings, up to 100% of project costs for 100% affordable housing or 75% of project costs for market-rate housing, max \$100,000 per property.

ELIGIBILITY

Apartments or condominiums with 4+ units located in the SVCE service area (all of Santa Clara County excluding the Cities of Santa Clara, Palo Alto, and San Jose).
