Among the many takeaways were:

- There is a need for more analysis and planning re: capacity and needs on the government agency side, including fleet and EVI at public facilities
- In addition to the data that SVCE has compiled on <u>special populations</u>, other data layers that illustrate capacity and current installed infrastructure would be valuable
- Another view of equity: in some communities, there is a workforce whose demographics and charging needs that don't match up with the residential demographics, so some programs may not fit
- Grant writing capacity is a need; SVCE could potentially help in multi-agency applications
